

The Draft Shining Hill Secondary Plan was presented at Public Information Centre #3

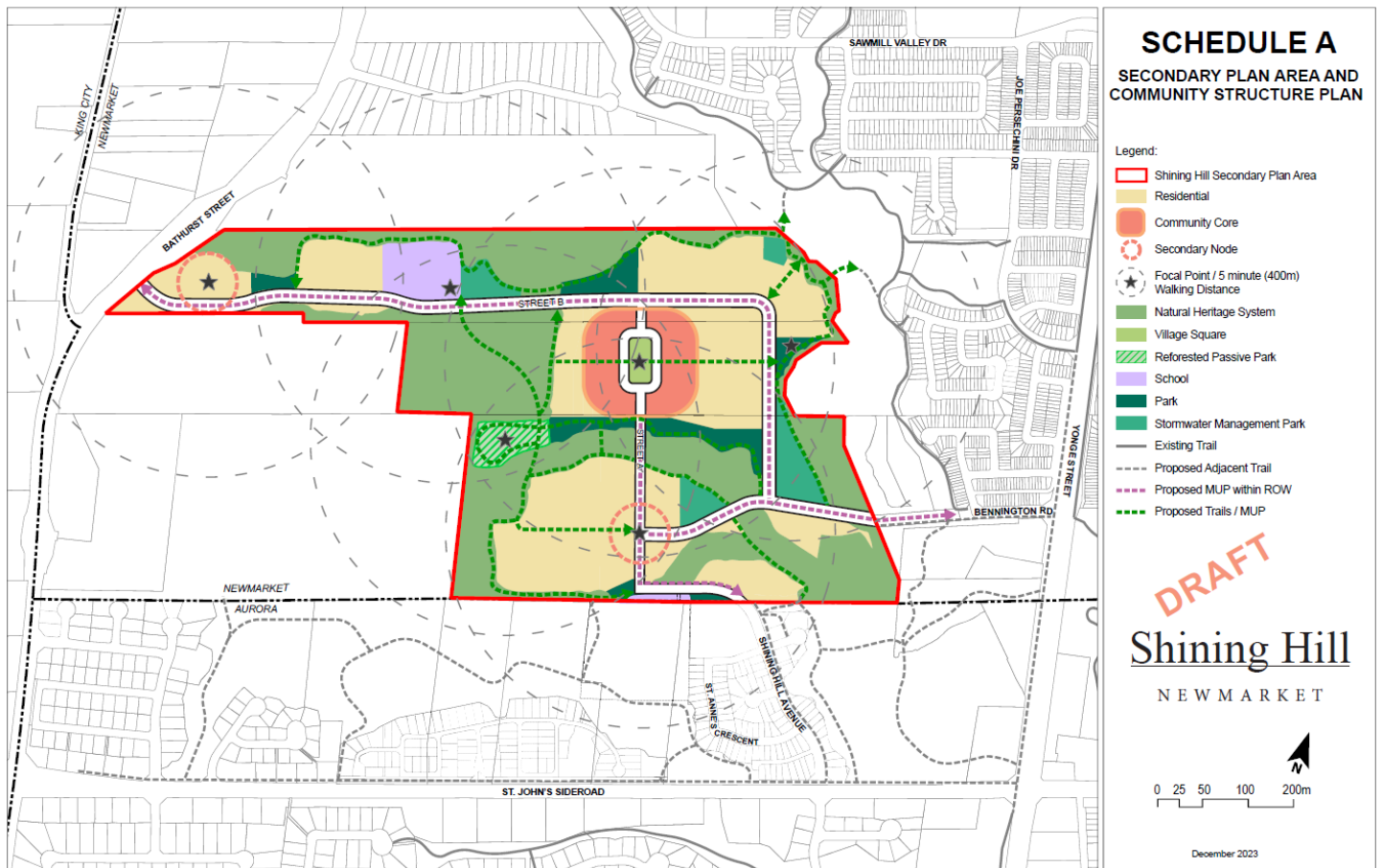
On April 2, 2024, the third Public Information Centre (“PIC 3”) for the integrated Shining Hill Secondary Plan and Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) was held in the Council Chambers of the Newmarket Municipal Offices. At PIC 3 the consulting team reviewed background information, the MCEA problem/opportunity statement, land use and transportation concepts and the feedback gathered from the previous PICs.



The event kicked off with a detailed presentation followed by an open Question and Answer period and then an open house where attendees could walk around, visit design options on poster boards and ask more questions.

The recommended land use and transportation concept for Shining Hill was presented as well as the draft Shining Hill Secondary Plan. Of the 3 Land Use and Transportation Concepts presented at PIC #2 (#1 Central Node and Spine, #2 Multi-destinations, and #3 Focused Grid), a combination / hybrid of Concepts #2 and #3 was recommended and presented as the Recommended Shining Hill Secondary Plan.

PIC 3 also introduced alternative and recommended design options for streets, watercourse crossings and intersections controls.
